

10 Questions To Ask at Your Parent-Teacher Conference

Does my student know what to do when he enters your classroom? Does he need to ask someone? Does he read the room? Or can he settle in on his own?

Does my child raise his hand and participate in class discussions?

What do you think my child is particularly good at?

What areas do you think need improving?

Does my child ask for help? Clarification? For you to repeat?

How does my student interact with other students when asked to do a group assignment? Is he all in? Take charge? Hangs back?

How is my child doing socially? Do other students seek him out and chat before class begins or does he come in to the class alone?

How is my child doing emotionally? Does he seem happy? Engaged? Withdrawn? On his own?

Can you tell me about your teaching method? Does my child respond to that?

Does my child do just what is asked or does he provide more information than requested?
